

# Do you have a spinal cord injury? Do you have severe neuropathic pain?

The University of Minnesota and Craig Hospital are studying effects of an investigational drug with individuals that have a spinal cord injury and severe neuropathic pain. If you are able to participate, we would like to study you over the course of three months. There will be three study visits, and we will ask you to take the investigational drug. This study will take place at the University of Minnesota (Minneapolis, MN) and at Craig Hospital (Englewood, CO).

#### To participate you must:

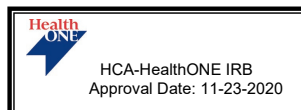
- Have completed inpatient rehabilitation and are living in the community
- Have severe below-level neuropathic pain (daily average 9/10 or 10/10)
- Tried and failed to achieve adequate pain relief with the use of other drugs and can continue to take spasmolytics, pregabalin, gabapentin, and opioids
- No progressive myelopathy
- No brain injury limiting ability to follow directions
- Not pregnant or lactating
- No epilepsy
- No impaired liver or renal function
- No contraindications to Brivaracetam
- No contraindications to MRI
