- He presents at Craig Hospital at Rancho Level V.
- Review of the records indicate that he has a left temporal and frontal injuries.
- He is eating a pureed diet and nectar liquids.

What would your first session look like?

What would your assessment look like over the first few sessions?

2. After your assessment, you have learned that the patient has global aphasia, inconsistently follows directions, and speaks in short phrases with significant paraphasic errors. He has no day-to-day recall. He is unable to state goals for treatment, but his wife wants him to talk to his children. Write a couple of goals you would begin with and describe your treatment approach.
