



Craig Hospital Intern Job Description

SUMMARY

The therapeutic recreation internship consists of 600 hours over a 15-week period supervised by a certified therapeutic recreation specialist. Craig staff will provide supervision and support the intern in gaining professional growth in a clinical setting through recreational programming and community-based opportunities.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Completion of majority of therapeutic recreation coursework
- Verification of enrollment at current university
- Evidence of liability coverage and worker's compensation through school
- Attestation form with completed vaccinations
- Evidence of a negative drug screen
- Completed background check
- BLS certification from American Heart Association

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES AND EXPECTATIONS

- Maintain a personal caseload of 4-6 patients, completing all necessary documentation including assessments, treatment plans, progress notes and discharge summaries
- Become familiar with Epic, online charting system, for scheduling, referrals, communicating with interdisciplinary teams
- Attend weekly patient conferences
- Attend weekly team rounds
- Planning and implementing group and 1:1 therapy sessions as they relate to program components
- Work with interdisciplinary team to plan and facilitate community-based outings
- Attend weekly meeting with intern supervisor
- Attend weekly department meeting
- Identify appropriate patient for case study and present to the TR department
- Develop and present inservice for TR staff
- Plan, organize and lead a major project
- Educate patients and families on resources and adaptations as they apply to all program components
- Assure confidentiality of patients at all times
- Conduct self professionally at all times
- Follow all Craig Hospital policies and procedures
- Assist TR staff as needed
- Have open communication and report all concerns, issues or questions to Supervisor
- Be responsible for meeting all expectations and completing all internship responsibilities as assigned by Supervisor
