Advancing Health Numeracy in Rehabilitation Practitioners who care for Patients in Disorders of Consciousness

Who is conducting the study and what is this study about?

Researchers from the Occupational Therapy department at Colorado State University are recruiting participants for a study to create clinical education and knowledge translation tools to better support the use of measurement concepts like responsiveness indices in clinical practice.

Who can join this study?

- Rehabilitation practitioners who work with patients in disorders of consciousness
- Family care partners who have taken care of a person in a disorder of consciousness
- Participants must be at least 18 years old and comfortable listening to and answering questions in English

Why should I join this study?

By helping create knowledge translation tools, you can help us make assessment tools for patients in disorders of consciousness easier to interpret, helping families and practitioners engage in care discussions.

What will I be asked to do?

Participants will be asked to engage in a 60-90 minute focus group during which they give feedback on prototypes of knowledge translation tools.
