BRIDGE WORK CLOSURES

MARCH 30 — MAY 19

Starting March 30, closures will be in place around Craig Hospital as we add another level to our bridge! Please review details below and be prepared to take alternate routes around the hospital. Thank you for your patience as we work to expand our campus to better serve our patients and families.



- During construction work hours from 7 a.m. - 4 p.m., the courtyard under the bridge will be closed.
- From 7 a.m. - 4 p.m., patients, families and visitors can travel through the East Building to access the West Building main entrance from Patient/Family Housing and the East Garage.
- After 4 p.m. daily, an accessible pedestrian route to the main entrance will be available along the West Building for staff, patient and visitor use. Cyclists must dismount.
- During construction work hours, an accessible pedestrian pathway will be available for Craig staff at the south end of the West Building
- to allow staff to enter and exit through the employee-only entrance.
- After 4 p.m., this sidewalk may also be used by patients, families and visitors to access an after-hours path to the main entrance along the east side of the West Building.
- The Level 3 bridge will be closed.
- The Level 2 bridge will remain open with flaggers present for intermittent holds. **Please avoid stopping or lingering on the bridge.**
- To help alleviate elevator traffic during this closure, staff and visitors are encouraged to use the stairs if able.
